

COOKIE POLICY

Third Parties assist the organisation to deliver banner advertisements and online communications. These third parties collect information about you to help understand the organisation offers, promotions and types of advertising that are most suited to you. The personal data collected is aggregated and you cannot be identified.

What Are Cookies?

A cookie is a small data file consisting of encrypted information placed and stored on your computer, mobile or other device by websites that you visit to recognise repeat users, facilitate the user's access to and use of a website and allow a website to track usage behaviours and compile aggregated data that allows a website to optimise functionality and improve its content. There is a simple procedure in the browser that allows users to accept or reject.

How Do We Use Cookies?

We use cookies for several reasons, including:

- Enabling users to obtain quotes from our website
- Ensuring the security of our customers
- Making possible certain site functionality; and
- Website traffic and visitor behaviour tracking.

The persistent cookies used on this website help us to improve the user experience of the site by giving us an insight into how it is being used. These include Google Marketing Platform cookies, which are used to compile anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how users use our website and to help us improve the site structure. You can remove cookies by following the directions provided in your internet browser's 'help' file.

Use of Cookies by Associated Websites and Third Parties

The organisation website may contain links to and from other websites. We accept no responsibility or liability for the content of these websites or the cookies they use. If you choose to visit another website via the organisation website, you will need to contact them separately to have your personal information deleted from any records they might hold. It is the responsibility of these websites to detail their cookies usage to you and to gain the relevant consents from you.

Managing, Disabling and Enabling Cookies

You have the ability to accept or reject cookies from any website by modifying the settings in your browser. If you wish to restrict or block the cookies which are set by the organisation website, you can do this through your browser settings.
